Waltham Forest Adult Learning Service – subcontracting rationale

Waltham Forest Adult Learning Service's (WFALS) approach to subcontracting is to extend the accessibility of provision for learners which fits with service's strategic objectives in order to enhance and widen opportunities available and access to expert provision. WFALS subcontracts to extend the breadth of its provision, broadening the range of sector subject areas that can be covered, to provide training opportunities for a range of learners at work and in the community. Subcontracting offers flexibility by delivering provision at times and venues convenient to learners and employers meeting demand from key stakeholders such as local employers or Jobcentre Plus.

One subcontractor in 22/23 academic year. This subcontractor has a contractual relationship with WFALS and are subject to a robust due diligence process. Subcontracts are only awarded where our due diligence determines that the subcontractor has the capacity to deliver provision to the expectations of WFALS and regulatory bodies including the ESFA, GLA and Ofsted.
